(b) Of those students, how many were residents of other towns before they moved into said group home, shelter or other social service agency?
2. How many students who reside in a group home, shelter or facility located outside of Framingham and operated by a private, non profit organization go to school in any of the Framingham Public Schools?
3. How many students who reside in a group home, shelter or other social service agency located in Framingham go to school in another school district?
4. Question by question, how many of the students mentioned in questions 1-3 live in properties that are taxed?
5. Question by question, how many of the students mentioned in questions 1-3 live in properties that are tax exempt?
6. Question by question, how many of the students mentioned in questions 1-3 are identified as special needs students?
7. How does the Framingham school system define when a student in the Framingham Public Schools becomes a Framingham resident?
8. How many students are brought to the Framingham Public Schools because of a social service program for them or their families?
9. (a) Are there additional net expenditures to the Town of Framingham to educate students who are identified as special needs students and who live in a social service agency, and if so, what are those costs?
