Framingham Massachusetts—the Hub of the MetroWest region of Boston - offers a unique blend of urban, suburban and rural

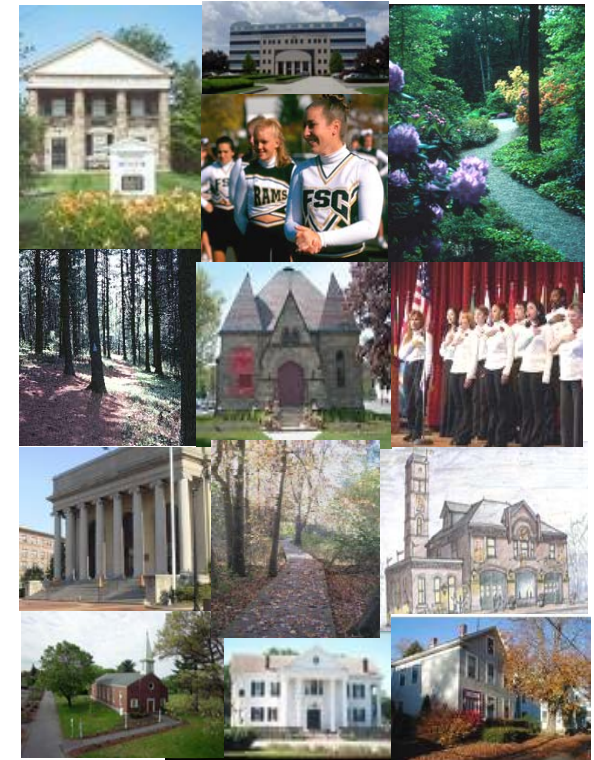
Founded in 1700 and located 20 miles west of downtown Boston, Framingham is rich in history, culture, convenience and opportunity.
